#### [Bachelor of Social Work \(Honours\)](#)

Bachelor of Social Work (Honours) will prepare you for numerous career paths including professional practice with individuals, groups, families, organisations, neighbourhoods and communities. The majority of social work qualifications in Australia are generic, meaning they prepare graduates to enter numerous sectors in the human services field. This course is accredited by the Australian Association of Social Workers (AASW).

#### [Bachelor of Psychological Science](#)

The Bachelor of Psychological Science provides students with a comprehensive overview of the discipline of Psychology. Throughout the course, students develop a broad knowledge of psychology and its applications, including theoretical perspectives within the discipline and an appreciation of the social and cultural contexts of psychological research and professional practice.

**Entry requirements** for either course includes an ATAR/TER in excess of 54 or a Certificate IV or Diploma.

**Students with Central Regional TAFE Diplomas in Counselling, Youth Work or Community Services receive 8 units of credit in the Bachelor Psychological Science course or enter into second year of the Bachelor of Social Work (Honours) course.**
