Yanburi Scholarship Program

The Yanburi program aims to promote and encourage Wajarri Yamatji (WY) into higher education streams thereby maximizing their opportunities for employment across all areas. The Yanburi program consists of 3 components:

- A **pre-math's bridging course** to WY students looking at entering the STEPS course at Geraldton Universities Centre (GUC).
- A STEP's course which assists students get into university (also available through GUC.)
- **Scholarships** will be made available to WY studying at a higher education level not only at GUC but at any university in Western Australia.

WY enrolled in STEP's will receive \$500 scholarship on commencement to assist with study costs. Once commenced in their higher education course, a laptop will be provided as part of the scholarship and payment of \$1000 per term for a period of up to 4 year's full time pro rata.

TAFE Program

The TAFE program aims to encourage Wajarri Yamatji (WY) into completion of TAFE courses to help optimise their opportunities for employment. The TAFE program consists of the following:

- **Funding** for subjects at \$250 per subject per term up to a maximum of \$1,000 per term.
- Once off funding for "tools of the trade" up to \$500 per person for items that are suitable for the course and ultimately usable for future work.
