



HOLLOMBY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

TERMS & CONDITIONS

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible for any scholarship through the Hollomby Foundation, you must be an Australian citizen, holder of an Australian Permanent Humanitarian Visa or a Permanent Resident of Australia.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- 1 Applicants will be assessed for all scholarships for which they meet the eligibility criteria. Only complete, on time applications, with all necessary attachments will be considered.
- 2 Assessment will initially be based on the quality of written information provided by the applicant and their referee. Those rated highly may be short listed for interview.
- 3 The interview panel will consist of representatives of donors, the GUC Director and Hollomby Foundation Committee of Management representatives.
- 4 The Panel reserves the right to award scholarships in whole or in part to whomever it considers the most deserving applicants.
- 5 Scholarships shall only be awarded where applications of sufficiently high merit are received.
- 6 All applications will be treated in strictest confidence.
- 7 The decision of the Selection Panel will be final and binding.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

- 1 The Scholarships will be administered by the Geraldton Universities Centre.
- 2 The award will be paid in equal instalments at or after the census date in each semester of the year awarded. In the case of a split scholarship, one payment may be made following the first semester census date.
- 3 Payment of the Award is subject to maintaining enrolment (full or part time depending on the conditions of the awarded scholarship) and Good Standing with the delivering university.
- 4 A recipient with unsatisfactory standing or who breaches the scholarship conditions shall be ineligible to retain the scholarship.
- 5 If a recipient needs to take leave of absence during the Scholarship year, the recipient must apply for and seek approval from the GUC Director to suspend the scholarship for the period of leave.
- 6 A recipient who withdraws from their course of study through the GUC during the year of the Scholarship will forfeit any future payment and will be required to repay the scholarship funds for that semester in full.
- 7 A recipient who transfers from their course of study at the GUC to another university during the scholarship period will forfeit any future payment and will be required to repay the scholarship funds for that semester in full.
