



## HOLLOMBY FOUNDATION TRAVEL BURSARY TERMS & CONDITIONS

### ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible for a travel bursary through the Hollomby Foundation, you must be a student enrolled in a Geraldton Universities Centre (GUC) supported course or a supported distance education student that is subject to a university partnership agreement with the GUC. \*

External students that are not subject to a university partnership arrangement with the GUC are ineligible to apply.

### CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

- 1 The \$500 travel bursary is non-competitive and open to students studying a mixed mode course supported by the GUC or a supported distance education student subject to a university partnership arrangement with the GUC, who is required to travel interstate to a residential school, not otherwise offered at the GUC.
- 2 The \$250 travel bursary is non-competitive and open to students studying the GUC supported USQ Bachelor of Nursing degree who are required to undertake a mental health placement at Graylands Hospital.
- 3 The Geraldton Universities Centre administers travel bursaries.
- 4 The travel bursary is paid in full prior to travel.
- 5 A recipient who withdraws from the unit or does not attend will be required to repay the bursary payment in full.
- 6 A recipient who fails the unit cannot reapply for a travel bursary to repeat the same unit at a future date.

\*The Hollomby Foundation Committee of Management reserves the right to approve special purpose travel bursaries that may be subject to specific funding arrangements with Hollomby Foundation donors.
