While the intent of the scholarship program is to support students who have the most financial need, it is not the only criteria that is used to award scholarships. The judges also consider your written responses to two questions that focus on community, and your personal ethos and approach to your study. There are also a limited number of scholarships that are awarded based on high academic achievement.

The application is online via <https://hollombyfoundation.scholarshipsplatform.com/>. If it is the first time you have applied for a scholarship, you will need to register. Read the application carefully as it provides lots of information on how to answer each question. Prior to submitting your application, please check your written answers carefully for spelling and grammar errors.

The Hollomby Foundation Scholarship application requires you to provide the following information:

1. Your Details
2. Your Course Information
3. Criteria you need to address (written response questions)
4. Your financial status – you will be asked a series of questions about your income and if applicable, combined household income. There is also an opportunity to indicate whether there are any circumstances that impact your family's finances.

Documents you need to provide

- Academic Results
- A reference (please see explanation below)
- Income statement/s
- Proof of full time enrolment in your course (please refer to scholarship [Terms and Conditions](#))

Why do we ask for a written reference?

Reference letters offer a personalised touch to your application by providing external context to your skills and character and can also be considered a letter of recommendation.

Your reference can be from a teacher or principal (if recent school leaver), employer or community organisation/sporting club that you are involved in. The reference must be dated and signed and be less than two years old. Your reference cannot be from someone employed at the GUC.
